1 Introduction

A student is enrolled at Snowy Mountains Grammar School on the understanding that their parents or guardians are sympathetic to the aims and policies of the School and will do whatever they can to ensure that he conforms to such regulations as the School deems necessary. Students and the School are judged by the general standard of each student's dress and appearance. Students are expected to know and comply with the dress and appearance regulations of the School. It is each student's responsibility to be correctly and neatly dressed, to be clean and tidy, free of jewellery and make-up, clean shaven (boys), to have their shirt tucked-in at all times and wearing the correct shoes.

Specific to boys: to have their tie neatly tied into the buttoned-up collar, no jewellery (watch accepted) and their hair cut in accordance to the school expectations. Specific to girls: to have their hair pulled back (with a ribbon), be free of make-up and jewellery, and have their dress at the required length.

Parents are expected to be familiar with the information in relation to uniform requirements outlined below and to ensure that these requirements are fully observed. Students will be asked to change any items not in accordance with the School's requirements. Each version of the School uniform must be worn complete and not worn with other non-uniform items of clothing. Students are required to keep their clothes clean and ironed and their shoes polished. Shirt buttons must be done up to the top collar and ties (if worn) properly in place. All clothes and shoes must be marked with the student's name. Regulation School Uniform must be worn within the school grounds. Full school uniform (including blazers) must be worn to all formal daytime events and at some evening functions, plays, musicals etc. without exception unless permission to do otherwise is given by the School in a specific instance. Jumpers may not be worn as the outer garment outside the school.

1.1 Hair

Boys must have their hair cut according to the SMGS requirements: Hair must not be long enough to be over the collar, lower part of the ears, eyebrows, nor overly full at the back or front. An all-over same length short haircut is acceptable to a minimum No.3 cut. Haircuts must be of a business conservative nature. Hair longer than stated above, 'mullet' styles, 'mohawk styles' or shaved sides are not permitted at SMGS.

Girls: (if below the collar) Hair must be pulled back from the face and tied with a navy, yellow or white ribbon (or scrunches). Dying of hair is not permitted.

In all respects, the School remains the final arbiter of what is acceptable. Students may be asked to remain at home until the hair meets the expectations of the School, as stated.

1.2 Jewellery

Girls may wear one pair of earrings (studs or sleepers only) in the lower lobe only. No other visible piercings are allowed. No jewellery may be worn other than watches, medic-alerts and approved badges relating to Snowy Mountains Grammar School.

2 Dress Regulations Outside of School Hours

In Terms 1, 2 and 4 - Weekday mornings and afternoons.

Students travelling to and from school on weekdays are required to wear the full school uniform including blazer. Students may wear their snow sports jacket to and from school in cold or wet weather, over their blazer.

2.1 In Term 3 – ONLY

The fleece or the soft-shell jacket may be worn in exchange for the blazer after the Queen's Birthday weekend and until the end of Term 3.

After sports practice, students may travel to and from sport in either full Snowy Mountains Grammar School uniform, only during the summer sports season, the gold or blue PE (collared) shirt with the PE short or designed sport uniform shorts is acceptable. The SMGS fleece or soft shell are part of the sports uniform and may be worn to and from school. Students who drive to school or those who are given lifts may travel in sports clothing provided that they go straight home. They may not appear in public places in part of their school uniform.

Each sport and activity undertaken by the school may require additional safety wear. It is a condition of participating in these activities that the designated safety wear is worn by the participating student. Students in K- 6 will wear their PE uniform to school on their PE lesson days. Students in Year 7- 10 will change into their PE uniform at the start of their practical lesson and return to full school uniform at the conclusion of the lesson.

Senior students must attend all examinations in full school uniform. Boarders may change into casual clothes provided they remain within the confines of their house or school grounds.

Girls may choose to wear long navy trousers and the white uniform blouse instead of the summer dress or winter skirt. The trousers to be worn must be approved by the Director of Junior School or the Director of Wellbeing before being worn as part of the uniform.

Shoes must be black leather lace-ups and fully-enclosed traditional school shoes. Gym shoe styles are not permitted. Velcro closures and Mary Jane style shoes are permitted in Years K - 4. For Years 5 – 12, all shoes must be fully enclosed to comply with safety requirements in some classes. Additional uniform requirements may be specified for some excursions.

The uniform shop is open weekly, each Monday lunchtime and after school on Thursdays. All new uniform items, apart from footwear, must be purchased from the schools' uniform shop. Any second-hand items must originate from the SMGS uniform shop and be part of the current uniform as set out in this guide.

3.2 Kindergarten to Year 12 Girls' Winter Uniform

- Blazer
- Woollen pleated skirt (hem at knee length or longer)
- Peter-pan collared white blouse
- V-neck navy jumper
- K - 10 grey stockings, Years 11 - 12 navy stockings
- Broad-brimmed felt hat, bucket hat or baseball cap
- Soft shell jacket (optional)
- School scarf (optional)
- SMGS navy school bag

3.3 Kindergarten to Year 4 Boys' Summer Uniform

- Blazer
- Grey elastic-waist shorts
- Blue short-sleeved shirt
- V-neck navy jumper
- Junior tie
- Grey socks
- Broad-brimmed felt hat, bucket hat or baseball cap
- Soft shell jacket (optional)
- SMGS navy school bag

3.4 Kindergarten to Year 4 Boys' Winter Uniform

- Blazer
- Grey elastic-back trousers
- Blue long-sleeved shirt
- V-neck navy jumper
- Junior tie
- Grey socks
- Broad-brimmed felt hat, bucket hat or baseball cap
- Soft shell jacket (optional)
- School scarf (optional)
- SMGS navy school bag

3.5 Year 5 to Year 12 Boys' Summer Uniform

- Blazer
- Grey shorts or trousers
- Black belt
- White short-sleeved shirt
- V-neck navy jumper
- Grey socks
- Junior tie: Years 5 – 10; senior tie: Years 11 – 12
- Broad-brimmed felt hat, bucket hat or baseball cap
- Soft shell jacket (optional)
- SMGS navy school bag

3.6 Year 5 to Year 12 Boys' Winter Uniform

- Blazer
- Grey trousers
- Black belt
- White long-sleeved shirt
- V-neck navy jumper
- Junior tie: Years 5 - 10; senior tie: Years 11 - 12
- Grey socks
- Broad-brimmed felt hat, bucket hat or baseball cap
- Soft shell jacket (optional)
- School scarf (optional)
- SMGS navy school bag

3.7 Additional Optional Winter Items - All Students

From the Queen's Birthday weekend until the end of Term 3:

- The soft-shell jacket can be exchanged for the blazer
- The skivvy can be exchanged for the shirt or blouse

3.8 Kindergarten to Year 4 Unisex Sports Uniform

- House colour polo shirt

- Navy microfibre shorts
- Navy microfibre track pants (optional)
- Soft shell jacket (optional)
- White ankle socks
- Broad-brimmed felt hat, bucket hat or baseball cap

3.9 Year 5 to Year 12 Unisex Sports Uniform

- Navy and gold polo shirt (Wednesday sport program, PE lessons, interschool competitions)
- House colour polo shirt (house sporting competitions and carnivals, option for PE lessons)
- Navy microfibre shorts
- Navy microfibre track pants (optional)
- Soft shell jacket (optional)
- White socks
- Broad-brimmed felt hat, bucket hat or baseball cap
- Sports shoes

3.10 Year 5 to Year 12 Unisex Snow Sports Uniform

- SMGS Snowsports jacket
